PHILIPPI: SHINE LIKE STARS

Philippians 2:12-18

Memory verse: "Do everything without grumbling and arguing." - Philippians 2:15

According to the book of Acts, Paul received a vision of a man in the province of Macedonia inviting him to come to the region to help them. Luke says that Paul, Timothy, and Silas left immediately, landing in the port of Neapolis and taking the short trek to Philippi, a Roman city in Macedonia that had been colonized by veteran Roman soldiers. There, they began to share the good news and planted what is considered to be the first church in Europe. Paul would visit twice more and later write a letter from prison to continue to encourage the young church. In the letter, Paul thanks the church for its faithful witness, then speaks of a core value of Christ: humility.
